It is hereby resolved that U. S. Flight Academy will extend the USFA Instructor Scholarship to _____, currently a student of U. S. Flight Academy. This scholarship constitutes that the U. S. Flight Academy will extend to the above named student part of the cost for the three (3) Instructor Certifications (MEI, CFI and CFII), executed according to FAR Part 61. The only cost USFA is not able to extend to the Scholarship Participant is the airplane only cost for the 15 hours P.I.C. requirement in the C-310 airplane per current airplane cost. The Instructor training is partially integrated in the Commercial training conducted, and is normally accomplished with the MEI Course first, followed by the CFI Course Single Engine, then after certain Instructor experience is attained, the CFII Course is conducted. The Scholarship participant can work as long as he desires at the U. S. Flight Academy and it is normally required that the Scholarship participant will need to work two (2) years as an Instructor with the U. S. Flight Academy. However, the U. S. Flight Academy realizes that under certain circumstances it could be better for the Professional Development of the Scholarship participant to be relieved from the USFA Duties earlier than two years. The Scholarship participant is also extended as a Representative of U. S. Flight Academy with all the benefits, rights and privileges this will indicate, and is bound by the Representative Agreement.
